HOMESTAY \$250/WEEK OR \$35/DAY

Live with Mwana (the founder) and her 11-year-old son in a welcoming family home near the school in a private room with access to a shared kitchen, bathroom, and water.

PRIVATE APARTMENT \$450-600/WEEK?

Prefer more independence? we can help you arrange a stay in a private apartment close to the school.

- Ideal for more quiet time or remote work.
- Great for volunteers who value independence but want to stay closely connected.

Airport pick-up from Mombasa (MBA) & transportation to the site.

INTERNET ACCESS

If you'd like to stay connected outside of school hours, we'll help you get a local SIM card. Mobile data costs around \$10–20/month — enough for browsing, messaging, and social media.

NOT INCLUDED:

Flights, visa, vaccinations, insurance, personal expenses, and SIM card.

We want to make sure budget isn't a barrier to creating deep, lasting impact. We offer a discounted volunteer fee for long-term stays.

WHAT ABOUT THE LOCATION?

BEST OF BOTH WORLDS

Majengo Waweni gives you that peaceful **village vibe**, but you're not far from the action. We're **40 min from Mombasa** (Kenya's second-largest city) and just **20 minutes from Mtwapa**, a buzzing town with bars, restaurants, and nightlife. Plus, **the school is only a 10-15 minute walk to the beach**, so your downtime can include beach sunsets and a swim!



EXPLORE MORE

If you're itching to explore beyond the village, we've got local contacts who can help set up **tours and safaris** to make sure you see the best of Kenya at a local price while you're here.

SAMPLE WEEKDAY SCHEDULE

Schedules may vary slightly depending on your role, but here's what a typical day could look like!



8:30 AM - HEAD TO SCHOOL

Support a class, lead your own session, or work on a personal project (e.g. content creation, foundraising, workshops).

10:00 AM - BREAKFAST BREAK

Enjoy a snack with the kids — often mandazi and tea — a great time to bond informally.

10:30 AM - 12:00 PM - MORNING ACTIVITIES

Lead a workshop, teach English, organize sports, or assist local teachers.

12:30 PM - LUNCH WITH THE KIDS

Eat together and share stories over a hearty, home-style meal of rice with either beans, lentils, vegetables, or local specialties.

2:00 - 3:30 PM - AFTERNOON SESSION

Continue with another chance to lead or assist a class, or work on your individual project.

3:30 - 4:30 PM - OPTIONAL ENRICHMENT

Join yoga, help with reading and soft skills, or propose your own activity — from football to art. This is your space to get creative!

4:30 PM - FREE TIME

Relax at your homestay, explore the area, or head to the beach.

Weekends are free to rest, join local activities, or explore Kenya. We can connect you with trusted guides for safaris, beach trips, or cultural experiences — all at local prices.
